The Hidden Secrets of God's Creation

Do you know what a microscope looks like? A microscope is a very powerful magnifying glass which helps us to see things too small for our natural eyes to see. (See diagram)



When we hold up our hands in front of our face we see two useful 'tools' that help us do so many things. But out of sight under the skin of these hands are millions of tiny cells that we cannot see. In fact, most adult human bodies have a huge sixty trillion cells in them. The entire world is made up of many billions of

tiny living things that are so small we can't see them without the use of a microscope.

There are different types of microscopes with different magnification strengths which are used for looking at tiny objects we want to study further. This has been a great benefit for us as this has opened up some of the amazing complex secret worlds of God's creation.


But before microscopes allowed such close examination of living things many people accepted the idea that living things could grow out of non-living things or nothing at all. This isn't true. The principle is always the same: nothing can make nothing. This is explained in John's Gospel Chapter 1 Verse 1: "Through him (the Lord Jesus – God's eternal Son) all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made." That means He owns it all too.

Each tiny human cell is extremely complex with many different parts. One of those parts must be in a set order from one to twenty or the cell will die. This means that not even one part of a living cell is able to come together to work correctly by accident and is mathematically impossible. Long periods of time cannot create anything from nothing.


Did you know that if our earth was further away from the sun than it is, we would live in never ending winter? And if our earth was closer to the sun, it would be so hot that we couldn't live here either. Our moon is in control of the tides in the oceans. If it was much bigger and stronger, waves of salt water would wash over the land. And if it was much weaker, the sea water would be so stagnant that it couldn't support living things.

The Bible reveals in many places that God (Father, Son – the Lord Jesus and the Holy Spirit) made everything. (Genesis 1; Job 38; Isaiah 45:18; John 1:13; Colossians 1:16; Revelation 4:11) God is the author of truth and we can trust His Word. But we should never trust everything said by people who refuse to accept God as creator and designer of the world and where it came from.

Our bodies too have many parts. (<u>1 Corinthians 12:18</u>) We have ears to hear and eyes to see- both are gifts from the Lord. (<u>Proverbs 20:12</u>) Let's give God thanks!
